- problems even with basic structures, and progressive verb forms overused

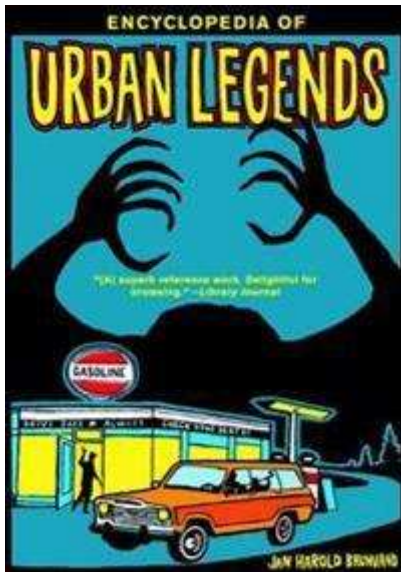
Text 6
